ALL COMPETITORS PAY ENTRANCE TO GROUNDS & CAMPING FEES

ALL TRUCKS, FLOATS & TRAILERS PLEASE USE THE THOMPSON STREET GATE

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY. ALL conditions must be absolutely adhered to.

IF COMPETITOR IS WAITING TO COMPETE IN A CLASS, Horse must be standing at right-angles with the RING FENCE and Hind-quarters Facing to the OUTSIDE to allow other Horses & Competitors to pass by IN SAFETY. It is also RECOMMENDED by the Committee that “When in MAIN ARENA, that ALL COMPETITORS WALK their Horses until Requested to Trot” [Especially in Ridden Classes].

ALL STALLIONS LED and RIDDEN must be handled by a person 18 yrs & over. ALL STALLIONS and COLTS MUST HAVE BAR, BIT OR CHAIN ON WHEN IN THE RING. Stallions shall not compete in Hack or Riding Classes unless there are specific Ridden Stallion classes offered.

The Committee reserves the right to alter or delete any event on this programme without notice. **ALL HORSES MUST PARADE or PRIZEMONEY AND RIBBONS WILL BE FORFEITED.** SECOND AND THIRD PRIZEMONEY will be awarded if there are four (4) or more entries in the class. IF ONLY ONE COMPETITOR IN A CLASS then only \$5.00 will be paid in Prizemoney. PRIZEMONEY will be available on the first day of the show at the conclusion of the PARADE for those events held prior to the Parade. **TREASURER’S OFFICE for PRIZEMONEY will be OPEN AFTER 2.00PM ON THE TUESDAY.** ALL other prizemoney will be available at the conclusion of the **GRAND PARADE** on the second day. **PARADE PASSES MUST BE PRESENTED TO OBTAIN PRIZEMONEY.**

PROOF OF AGE OF RIDERS to be made available to Stewards on request. Age as at the first day of Show. Approved Equestrian Head Gear of Standard AS/N 3838; EMI 1384 or ASTNF 1163 MUST be worn by ALL competitors under the age of 17 yrs.

MEASURING CERTIFICATES Those horses that have current EFA or RAS certificates (issued within last 12 months) will be accepted. Pony Breed Societies height certificates will also be recognized. ALL other horses that need height certificates to be measured.

THE MEASURER will be available on Tuesday between 7.30am-8.30am and Wednesday between 8.00am-9.00am. No further measuring of horses will take place outside the specified times. **PROTESTS** must be lodged with the Secretary in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$50.00. Protest to be heard by the President, Vice-President and Ringmaster. If protest lodged in relation to height of horse, **ALL three** to be present at time of re-measuring. If protest is upheld \$50.00 will be refunded, if dismissed it becomes the property of the Kempsey Show Society.

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES may be checked so please ensure you have a photocopy of each side of your horse's registration certificate on you when entering your respective class. ALL horses entered in Registered Breed events **must be Registered** in their respective Stud Books or Breed Societies.

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AND ELECTRICAL LEADS Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that **ALL** electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is **essential** for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1983. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. **PLEASE CHECK ALL YOUR ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AND LEADS BEFORE YOU COME TO THE SHOWGROUND AND AVOID THE OCCURRENCE OF ANY DIFFICULTIES. ELECTRIC FENCES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE SHOWGROUND.**

HORSE STALLS: Must be reserved with the Secretary, Post Office Box W121, West Kempsey NSW 2440. Stalls are \$5.00 each for the duration of Show. Cheque must accompany booking. Stallion stalls available at the Showground. **CAMPING FEES:** A fee of \$15.00 will apply for the duration of the Show for those persons wishing to camp on the grounds and/or use the available facilities. **ENTRIES** taken during the Show unless otherwise stated. Competitors must present entry ticket to Stewards or they will not be permitted to compete.

ANIMALS COULD BE TESTED FOR DRUGS. DOGS MUST BE ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES.

UNREGISTERED: Classes for horses not registered with any Breed Society.

MAIDEN: A horse that hasn't won a 1st prize in a similar event.

NOVICE: Means Horses must not have won a Championship at any Show.

INTERMEDIATE: Hasn't won 1st, 2nd or 3rd at a Royal Show

ALL COMPETITORS COMPETE AT THEIR OWN RISK AND MUST SIGN A WAIVER FORM.

Judging to take place in three rings at the same time. **CLASSES WILL NOT BE UNDULY HELD UP TO ALLOW EXHIBITS TO COMPETE IN MORE THAN ONE RING AT A TIME.**

ALL juniors under 17 years \$2.00.

PRIZEMONEY: 1st \$10.00 2nd \$5.00 3rd \$2.00
